TN-M Visit TN-T Gathering to capture the TN Traveling Plaque, Mar 27th Brian Richards

We had 9 of us (Loretta & I, Mel & Renee, Randy & Marlene, Russ, Burl and George) all braving the heavy rain, and even some hail, on Saturday, March 27th to get to the TN-T Knoxville gathering. Russ, of course, was on his motorcycle, thank goodness for rain suits! Loretta & I really want to thank the rest of our "crew" for ignoring the lousy weather and joining us in our hopes of capturing the Tennessee Traveling Plaque from TN-T. To capture this plaque, any visiting chapter, to be eligible, has to have a minimum of 5 members. The miles from the visiting chapter's gathering location to the plaque holding chapter's gathering location is calculated, and the number of members are totaled then multiplied by the mileage calculation (anyone that rides gets credit for double miles) to result in the total number of miles traveled by that chapter. Then of all the visiting chapters, the one with the most total miles gets awarded the plaque. We obviously had more than the minimum number of members, and since no other visiting chapter was there, it was a forgone conclusion that TN-M "captured" the plaque. 


