Speaking of good weather, for riding days of course, we're close to a TN-M 2022 Ride Calendar. With the help of many of you, we got a good list of suggestions for day rides, weekend rides, and multi-day rides, sent the list for the members to rank their preferences, and we have a ranked list. We'll set up a "Ride Planning" meeting with all the interested members, to plunk the selected rides into the calendar, so be watching your emails for a date and time for that meeting. There's lots of good choices so we'll get a good calendar set up with rides to meet most all members' preferences.

The TN District Spring Fling rally is getting close, and we certainly hope you have already registered for it, or are seriously considering participating, it is looking to be a great time. Hearing about the plans from the District Team, there's going to be fun for everyone. You'll see information about Spring Fling activities on the schedule you receive when you check in, and the schedule is also available on the TN District website. There'll be lots of things to do to keep us occupied, there will be fun stuff, games to play, a bike and lighted bike show, a COY reunion, a mascot contest and talent contest. There's also helpful activities, Friday they have a Medic First Aid class, and this can be very helpful, not only to help you move up or renew your certification in the Levels program, but having the knowledge may save someone's life.

The District Team needs help. If you plan on being there and are willing to volunteer a couple hours of your time, please let me know and I will provide a list to the District for them to work with. Knowing the days you would prefer will help a lot. And the District Team is sincerely requesting you to seriously consider registering at the Ramsey Hotel. Comparatively speaking, the cost is reasonable for a quality hotel, and it includes a full buffet breakfast (not a grab-n-go bag!). If we fill the hotel, they will lock it out to the general public and we will have free reign to use all the areas, which will help a lot for setting up for the games, the seminars, etc.

Along with all the fun stuff listed above, as we've done previously, our chapter Ride Coordinator, Russ Wools, and Ken Gray from the Ride Team stepped up and came up with a couple more rides as requested by the District Director, Dennis Peterson, and the District Ride Coordinator, Bob McClung. The tentative plan is to use the same three rides we came up with for last year's Spring Fling, and add two more, slightly longer rides, and we believe the rides will be advertised as guided or self-guided. We will provide detailed maps and turn-by-turn instructions for anyone that wants to do them on their own, as well as for the Ride Leaders selected for the guided rides. The three from last year were "shorter" rides, and the two new ones are longer, up to about 3 hours depending on the time spent at the planned stops. We believe it will be set up for a ride Thursday afternoon, one Friday morning one Friday afternoon, one Saturday morning and one Saturday afternoon. If you are a qualified Road Captain and would be willing to be a Ride Leader for one of those rides, please let me know as soon as possible so I can coordinate with Bob McClung so he will have a list to work with.

Also for Spring Fling, the District has asked every chapter to donate a "Couple Of the Year" basket, tickets will be sold, and the person can put their ticket(s) into a bag in front of the basket or baskets they would like to win. The funds are for reimbursement to the District Couple Of the Year to cover their costs for any traveling they do promoting the TN District (such as other District rallies). The District has also asked each chapter to donate pre-wrapped (store bought) goodies for the Hospitality room. If you would be willing to donate for the basket, or goodies, please bring them to the chapter's March gathering on Tuesday, March 8<sup>th</sup>, or at the latest the April gathering on Tuesday, April 12<sup>th</sup>, thank you.
