TN-M ROMEOS Ride, April 20th

Joe and Pete arrived at the Cracker Barrel around 9:15 am. We had a brief rider's meeting at 9:20 am and left shortly after the rider's meeting since we weren't expecting anyone else to show up for the ride. We took 321 through Lenoir City and then got on the Tellico Parkway (Rte. 444). It was a beautiful day for a ride. The sun was shining and the temperature was near 50 degrees when we started the ride. At the intersection with 72, we turned left and went to Vonore. Then we turned right on 411 South and took that all the way to Englewood. There was very little traffic and we were enjoying the ride. In Englewood, we turned left on Route 39. This a lovely little highway with plenty of exciting curves and elevation changes. It follows a little creek for several miles and has many nice views of the countryside. When we got close to Tellico Plains, we turned right on Route 315 and took that to Reliance. More curves, elevation changes and awesome scenery was enjoyed by all. The temperature was near 60 degrees by now and still very little traffic. In Reliance we turned right on Highway 30 and stopped at a picnic area for a restroom break and to take off a layer as I was starting to get a little warm. We continued on 30 West and then turned right on 411 North. We stopped for lunch at Jessica's Place. I had never eaten there before but it turned out to be a great place to eat. 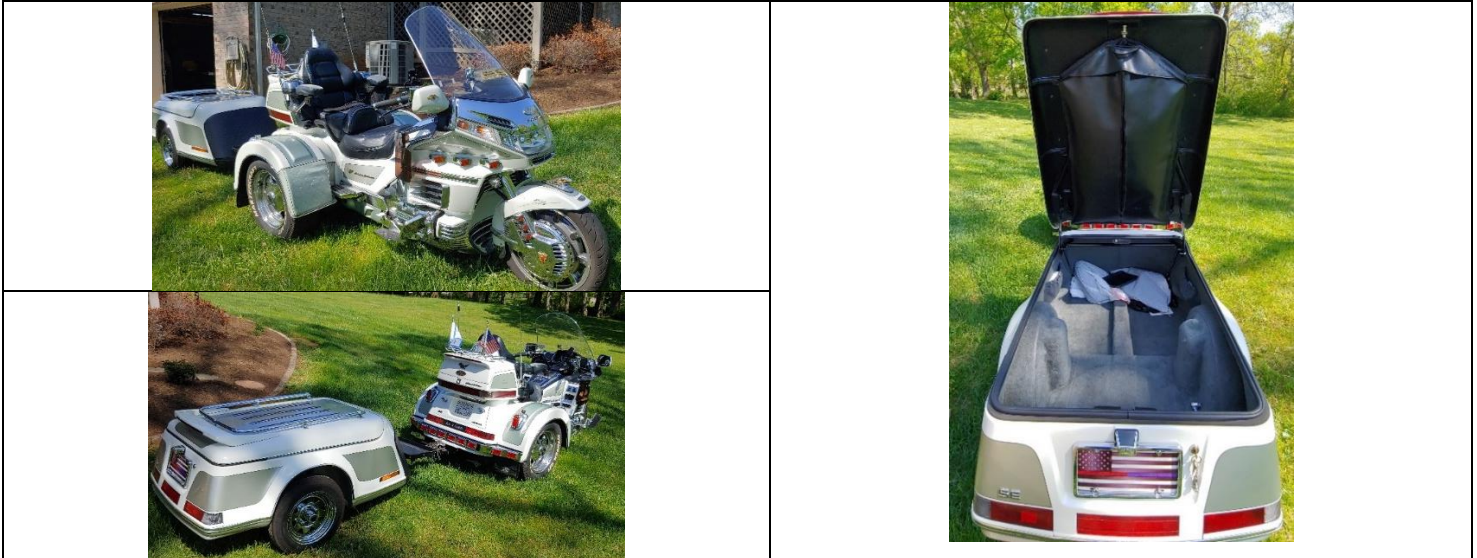

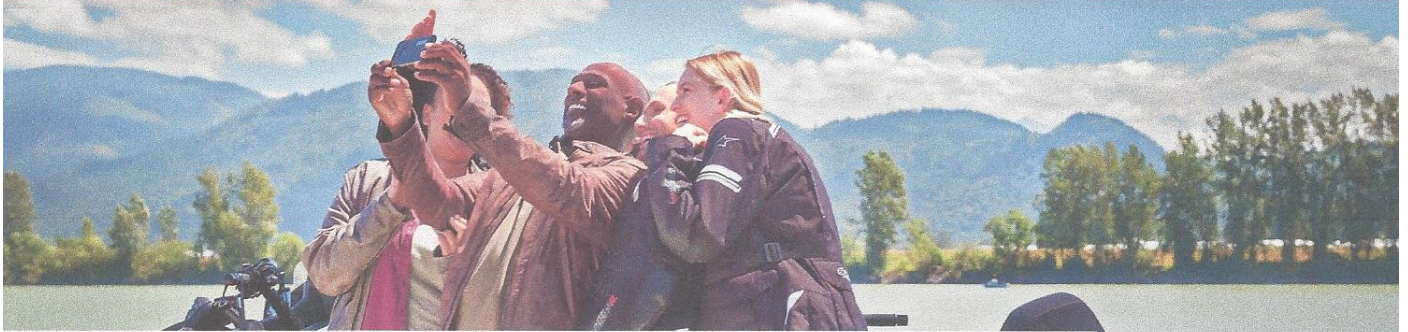
Some "Fun" stuff to brighten your day.

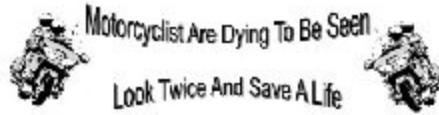
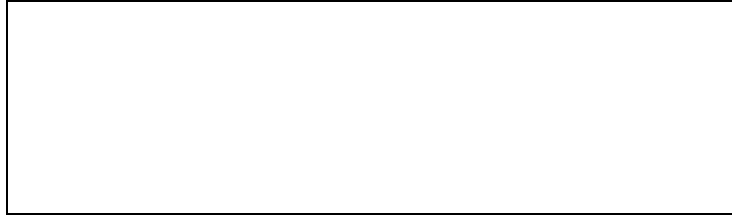
