## **Chapter M “Out Having FUN!”**

### **ROMEOS Ride, Nov 15<sup>th</sup>**

**Ken Gray**

I arrived at the Cracker Barrel around 8:35 a.m. The sky was cloudy and the temperature was around 48 degrees. Brian arrived about ten minutes later. No one else showed up, so we left around 9:00 a.m. heading towards Greenback. From Greenback we took highway 411 over to Vonore and then highway 360 to Tellico Plains. We rode on the Cherohala Skyway over to Robbinsville, North Carolina. Temperature up on the Skyway was around 50 degrees and increased to around 60 degrees in Robbinsville. The traffic was light and we had no one in front of us while we rode briskly through the curves along the Cherohala Skyway. South of Robbinsville we took highway 74 West to Andrews. We stopped for lunch at a little hamburger joint in Andrews called the Burger Basket. It was very good and I will probably eat there again when I am in that area. The clouds had thinned out a bit and the temperature was around 65 degrees by the time we finished lunch, so we removed a layer before heading on down the road. We continued on 74 West past Murphy and then turned on to highway 294 and rode that over to highway 68. This section of highway between Turtletown and Tellico Plains has a lot of fun curves. But we didn't get to enjoy them very much because we got stuck behind a slow-moving box van for several miles. We encountered a few passing zones, but I don't like to use them on a two-lane highway because you never know when someone is going to pull out of a driveway or another vehicle will start coming the other way when you are right beside the vehicle you are trying to pass. Also, the vehicle being passed always seems to accelerate on the straightaway while you are trying to pass it. After about the third passing zone my frustration level got to be too much, so I decided to go for it at the next passing zone. Brian and I got around the box van safely and then we had a wonderful time riding briskly through the curves with no one directly in front of us. When we got to Madisonville, we turned on highway 411 and rode that back to Vonore. I turned on highway 72 in Vonore and headed back to Lenoir City while Brian went straight heading back to Maryville and Corryton. I got home around 3:30 p.m. For me, the ride was 261 miles, driveway to driveway. Brian reported that for him, it was 290 miles, driveway to driveway.
