Ride to Cumberland Mountain State Park and a 3 Mile Hike, Apr 13th

The temperature was 44 degrees when I got ready to leave my house, so I put on a few extra layers for the ride to Lenoir City. I arrived at the Cracker Barrel around 9:25 am. and the temperature was already close to 50 degrees. Russ arrived a few minutes later and then Butch a few minutes after that. Butch and I were the only ones doing the hike, so we got ready to leave around 9:45 am. Bill arrived as we were getting ready to go, but said he did not want to do the hike. Butch and I headed out around 9:50 am, a few minutes later than I had hoped. We took highway 70 to Crossville and we arrived at Cumberland Mountain State Park around 10:10 CST. Wow, what a beautiful day for a hike. The temperature was around 60 degrees with a light breeze, clear blue skies and best of all, there were no bugs flying around to bother us while we were hiking. The trail was a little damp after experiencing four days of rain, but there was no deep mud because the trail was relatively hard packed. Butch and I really enjoyed the hike. Total miles for me was 260, driveway to driveway.
