Ride to Cumberland Mountain State Park and a 3 Mile Hike, Apr 13th Ken Gray

The temperature was 44 degrees when I got ready to leave my house, so I put on a few extra layers for the ride to Lenoir City. I arrived at the Cracker Barrel around 9:25 am. and the temperature was already close to 50 degrees. Russ arrived a few minutes later and then Butch a few minutes after that. Butch and I were the only ones doing the hike, so we got ready to leave around 9:45 am. Bill arrived as we were getting ready to go, but said he did not want to do the hike. Butch and I headed out around 9:50 am, a few minutes later than I had hoped. We took highway 70 to Crossville and we arrived at Cumberland Mountain State Park around 10:10 CST. Wow, what a beautiful day for a hike. The temperature was around 60 degrees with a light breeze, clear blue skies and best of all, there were no bugs flying around to bother us while we were hiking. We are so blessed to have such wonderful weather and beautiful roads and scenery for riding motorcycles in East Tennessee. I am already looking forward to our next ride. I got home around 3:45 pm. Total miles for me was 260, driveway to driveway.




