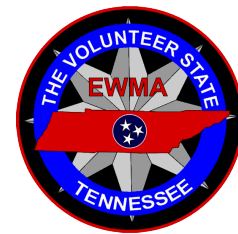

Friends for Fun, Safety & Riding

Chapter Director's Spiel



Well, we've sure had an interesting (???) time recently dealing with our local weather the last several weeks, boy, this winter is not being kind to a LOT of our country.

We're looking forward to getting back into "riding" weather (allowing of course for the few die-hards out there – and you KNOW who you are) and having some enjoyable rides to participate in – be sure to check out my article below about the planning for the 2025 TN-M Ride Calendar). Here at the start of new year, we can start thinking about rides we want to go on, and we can look forward to some fun times together.

As we are getting more involved in a new year, I just wanted to put a question out there to all the chapter members. Our main focus is to provide something that meets each of your needs related to your joining this wonderful Association, and our chapter. We know that individual "rides/activities" can't meet the needs/desires of everyone, different people have different requirements, but the advantage of the Association is to have multiple activities planned so that, hopefully, there are some that meet each member's wants. If there's some specific thing that you'd like to see, please let either myself or Russ Wools know, so we can look into it.

And thinking about our Association, what helps it be healthy and strong, is strong AND growing membership. EWMA and the members are doing a fairly good job bringing in new members, many of the existing members are diligently out there recruiting new members, and we strongly encourage everyone to be actively working on that idea. If you see someone out there, at the gas station, at a store's parking, or wherever, be proactive and ask them about their motorcycle, what they like to do, etc., and work on discussing the EWMA as a great method for them to further their enjoyment of their "hobby". But there's another aspect of this situation, while EWMA keeps getting new members, the other side of the coin is KEEPING those members, and that takes time and effort, we need to bring them in and get them interested and involved. I have had instances where talking with a member that had joined for a year and subsequently let their membership lapse, and when asked "Why", was told that they never heard from anyone about getting involved. Retention is a strong partner to Recruitment, and we all need to work together, to make new members welcome and get them to participate and learn how much fun they can have. And one aspect that can REALLY help is to let them know about all the extra benefits that come with their EWMA membership. And do YOU know what those benefits are? The best way doesn't take much effort. Log into the EWMA website (*) and to the left of the title line near the top of the page is "Member Benefits" (**). Hover the mouse cursor over the "Member Benefits" to see a drop-down box, move the mouse cursor to the "Benefits & Services" link and click it. This brings up a new page and you can scroll down the page seeing all the current benefits available to members. And as an aside, the EWMA Vice Presidents of Membership Benefits, Bill & Cheryl Smith, are busy looking for more possible benefits they can arrange to get added to the list, so get in the habit of periodically re-checking that list. The hotel discounts can be extremely useful, saving quite a bit on all our travels. Another useful benefit, but one that requires each member's input, is the EWMA's "Eagle Book", which is its version of the annual book that the "other" association put out providing information about what services members were willing to provide to other members. Eagle Book does the same thing, except it's not a real book, it is an on-line system that any member can access while out on the highways, to look for help. You select any area that you are in and look up members and find out what they can provide, such as a truck and/or trailer, tools, local guide services, temporary lodging (in-house or camping in the back yard), etc. But this "book" can only be fully useful if all the members log into their profile and indicate what services they are willing/able to provide. The way to update your profile is to log in to the EWMA website, hover the mouse cursor over the "Member Benefits" to see the drop-down box, move the mouse cursor to the "Profile" link and click it. To the far-right is a box titled "Your Website Functions", click on the "Eagle Services" link in that box and it opens up a separate page with all the possible options. Look down the list and click the box to the left of each option you are willing/able to provide a fellow EWMA member. When you're done selecting all the options, make sure you scroll to the bottom of the page and click the "Save" button.

(*) The URL is www.ewma-world.org and to login, you need to know your user ID and password. When you first joined EWMA, you received an email (as long as the email address you provided on the membership application was correct) welcoming you to EWMA and providing you with your special login ID and password, with the indication that after you logged in, you could change your password to something more relevant to you. If you lost that email, or didn't receive one (wrong email address provided, or you don't have an email address),

you can find out what it was by contacting the EWMA Vice President for Technology & Communication, Mike Melton at technology@ewma-world.com or calling 843-847-1444.

(**) When a member logs into EWMA website and threads down to the Member Benefits page, he will see all the benefits currently available, AND how to access those benefits, which usually requires registering with the benefit provider, and the only way you will see those instructions is by logging in to the EWMA website as an EWMA member. Non-members ARE able to do an internet search and find the EWMA website, and if they look through it, will see a lot of the information about the Association, what it stands for, etc., but they will not be able to see members' personal information, AND, in the case of the benefits, they will see a list showing the companies, but not how to access those benefits

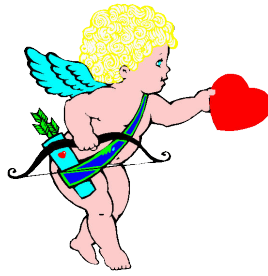

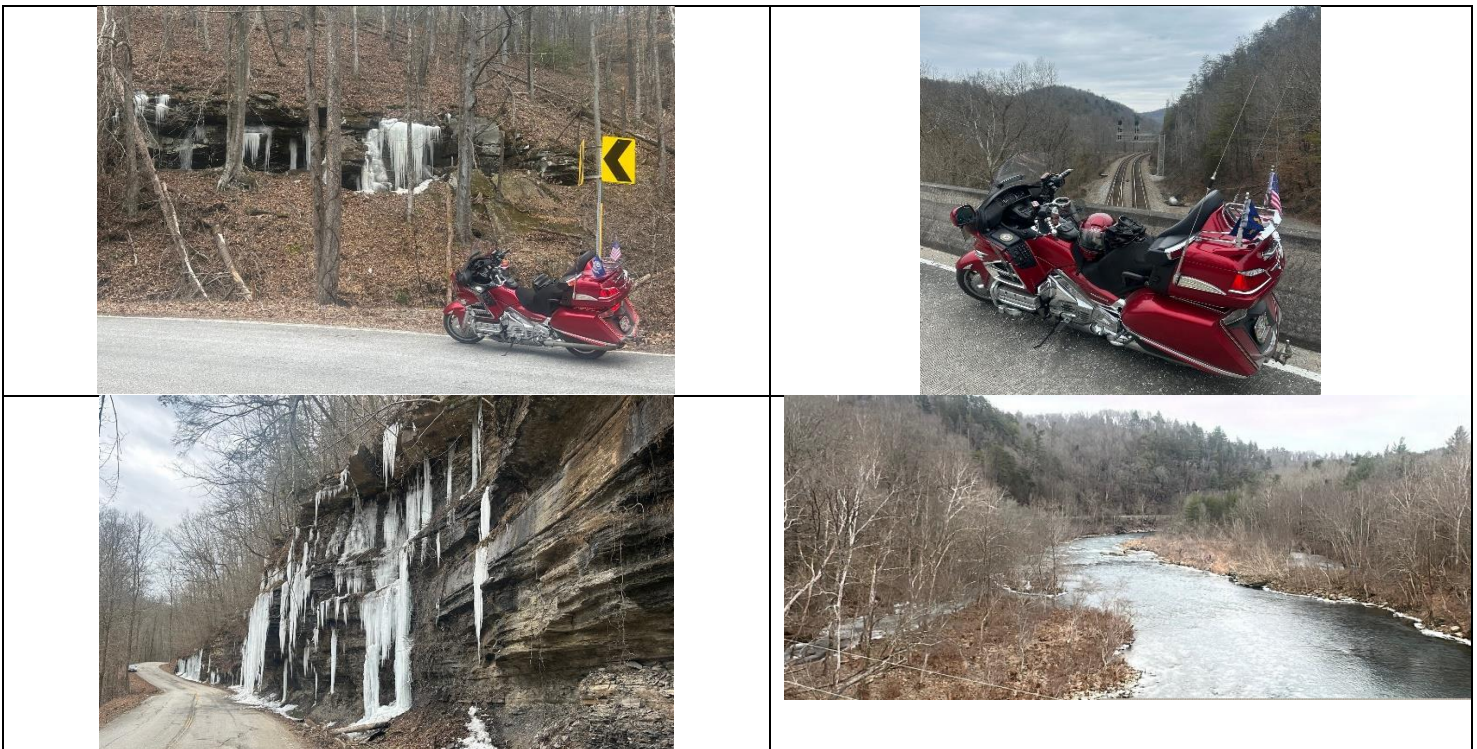

Chapter M "Out Having FUN!"

Riding Withdrawal Symptoms? Russ Wools

After 23 days of not being able to ride either due to weather or the residual salt on the roads, I finally gave in to my withdrawal symptoms and went riding today. Yes, there is still salt out there; but I needed to ride. I rode hwy. 58 to Blair rd. I then took hwy. 62 to Oliver Springs. I then rode 2/3 of the Devils Triangle. I was a bit surprised by the ice/snow on the side of the road on rte. 330 right after turning north. I expected to see ice/snow in the area of Frozen Head state park, but not there. There was still ice where the water flows down the hills alongside the road in various places. About halfway down the rt, the 116 leg to the Brushy Mtn. prison, the ice actually touched the edge of the road. The triangle now has 3 places that are down to a single lane with traffic lights controlling those areas. Two are near the prison that have been there for over a year. The other is less than a mile from the triangle crosses the railroad tracks, at the top of the triangle. It appeared that part of that area had slid off the side damaging the asphalt. The good thing was the roads were all clear. After Petros, I took rt 62 to Wartburg, then US-27 toward Harriman. I then took rt 328 to Oakdale. I then rode back along Camp Austin rd to Camp Austin for a stop on one of my favorite train watching areas on the bridge. After waiting for a train that never showed up, I continue on to White Oak rd. I took Riggs Chapel back to Harriman. I continued on to Swan Pond rd. back to Hwy 70 in Kingston. I then headed home after a very enjoyable ride. I then gave my bike a wash and dry to get any salt off of it. This is not how I describe it to Giselle, but I have to keep it PG in the newsletter. Hopefully the rain tonight will get the rest of the salt off the road. Total of 115 miles.



TN-M 2025 Ride Calendar **Brian Richards**

Well, as per the usual requirements for entering a new year, one of the tasks is to develop a calendar of chapter rides for the year. Knowing up front that no matter how much we plan, things will change throughout the year, rides get cancelled due to weather, timing conflicts, etc., but at least we have a starting point.

We had a really good initial planning session immediately following our January chapter gathering, most everyone stayed after to come up with suggestions for rides to be put into the calendar. After keeping a list of all the suggestions, it went on to step two. I created a list of all the suggestions and sent it out as an email to all the chapter members, asking them to give a ranking number to each ride, in each ride section, of which we have three: one-day rides, weekend rides, and multi-day rides. The ranking is picking the ride in that section that you most want to participate in, and give it number one, the next ride is number two, etc., and do the same for all three sections. I received a good majority of replies to that email and input each member's ranking numbers into a spreadsheet. When I had all the responses I was going to get, a quick sort of the total points for each ride in each section in descending order gave me a list of the rides the majority of the members were interested in, and the next, and the next. Once I had the list all worked out, we had a second meeting, on Tuesday, January 28, to pick dates in the calendar to put the rides onto. The calendar already contained things like the monthly chapter gatherings, the monthly chapter dinner get-togethers, the monthly chapter ROMEOS (Retired Older Members Eating Out Sociably) rides, and things like the official EWMA rallies (the Rendezvous, this year in Fort Smith Arkansas, Aug 28-30, and the EWMA International Ride-In in Sault Ste Marie Ontario, Jun 20-21), and all the Region A District Rallies (several are indicated in this newsletter and registration forms and flyers attached below).

We had a good turn-out at that second meeting and came up with some good planning to be able to complete the TN-M 2025 Ride Calendar, which will be available for viewing on the TN-M website, at www.ewmatn-m.org.
